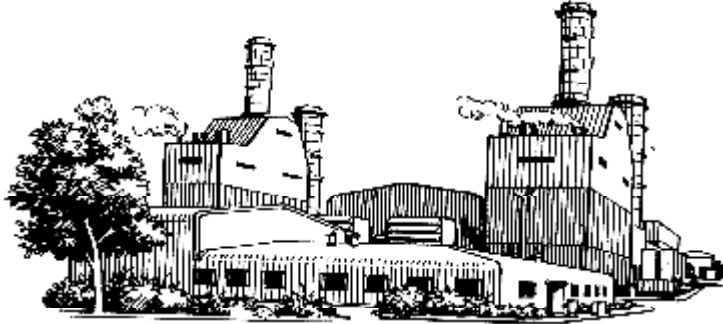

## MEET CONDITIONS AND RULES

1. The competition will be held under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules of Swimming and the event is LICENSED by the ASA for entry into National and Regional Championships. Officials will be from National and Regional lists of the ASA.
2. The ASA License number is 2ER0006
3. Age as at 11<sup>th</sup> April 2010
4. The events are:

	50m	All 4 Strokes	All Age Groups
	100m (Boys)	All 4 strokes	11yrs-16+yrs
	100m (Girls)	All 4 strokes	10yrs-16+yrs
	200m	All 4 strokes	All Age Groups

5. The age groups are
  - a. 100m events Boys 11yrs and under, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs, and 16+yrs
  - b. 100m events Girls 10yrs and under, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs, and 16+yrs
  - c. All over events 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs, and 16+yrs
6. All events are Heat Declared Winner.
7. Awards will be given to the top 3 placed swimmers in each age group in each individual event. There will be no presentations. Awards can be collected from the award collection point when the results have been announced.
8. In addition to the individual awards there will be a Top Visiting Club Award and an Overall Top Boy and Top Girl Awards calculated by means of a points system i.e. 6,5,4,3,2,1 for 1<sup>st</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> place respectively in relation to each age group.
9. Heats will be swum with all age groups combined and swimmers seeded by entry times. All heats will be spearheaded.
10. Overhead starts will be used at the promoter's discretion.
11. Pool length is 25m (6 lanes) and is equipped with electronic timing and anti-wave lane ropes. All events start and finish at the deep end of the pool.
12. The entry fee is £4.50 per event. (Cheques payable to City of Peterborough SC Gala Account please). All entries must be on the official form (photocopies accepted) and must include the entrants ASA Identity Number together with all entry fees. Entry times should be converted to 25m pool times. Entries will only be accepted from swimmers who have achieved the Qualifying Times. No entries will be accepted after the closing date or during the meet unless due to promoters error or omission.
13. Entries will be on a first come first served basis with the final date for entries being Monday 15<sup>th</sup> February 2010. Once each event is fully subscribed, any further entries received for those events will be rejected.
14. This will be a card-less meet. No cards will be issued prior to the event; the confirmation of entry will be posted on the Club's website ([www.copsclub.co.uk](http://www.copsclub.co.uk)). Please check this for accuracy.
15. Competitors must 'sign-in' for each event entered. Sign-in closes 20 minutes after the commencement of warm-up for each session.
16. Competitors must report to the Competitors Stewards when called. Any competitor not reporting on time for their event may be excluded from that event.
17. Competitors will only be allowed on poolside for the session in which they are competing and will only be allowed in the spectator area if wearing appropriate clothing and footwear.
18. Coaches' passes are available to coaches supporting competing swimmers at a cost of £12 (3 days) or £7 (one day). The passes include a programme, but not meals. Maximum of 2 coaches passes per club. No person will be allowed on poolside without a pass. Only competing swimmers and officials will be allowed in the area behind the starting blocks at the deep end of the pool.
19. Result sheets will be posted on poolside and the spectator area on the day and will be available to download from [www.copsclub.co.uk](http://www.copsclub.co.uk) after the event.
20. Spectator entry is with identifying band or badge which must be worn at all times and shown on re-entry to the spectator area. Spectator admission charges are:
